Uncharted Rock off Hainan Head.

NOTICE is hereby given that the S.S. *Shantung* is reported to have struck an uncharted rock off Hainan Head. From the rock, Hainan Bluff (highest part) bore S. 31° E., magnetic, distant 8 cables.

It is estimated that the depth of water over the rock is 18 feet at low water of spring tides.
