The five Mooring Buoys shown on the Weihaiwei charts as lying within the Three-fathom Line of the Liukungtao Anchorage, *i.e.*, off the south coast of the island between the Iron Pier and the Military Pier, have been moved and now lie further out ; they are marked with letters A to E, and are now in the following positions :—

A	in position where Cowan Pier Beacon bears S. 41° W. (true), distant 348 yards.

C	" " " " S. 17° E. " " 368 "
D	" " " " S. 33° E. " " 500 "
