No. S. 232.—With reference to Government Notification No. S. 150 of the 10th May, 1912, it is hereby notified that information has been received from the Consul for France to the effect that the quarantine restrictions imposed by the Government of Indo-China against the port of Hongkong have been withdrawn, but that, until the 15th August, Asiatic passengers will be subjected to medical inspection on board before being allowed to land.

Refuse of new goods coming direct from the weaving-mills, from workshops where apparel is made or from bleaching-establishments, artificial wool, and cuttings of new paper, are not considered as rags.
