Description:—Iron frustum of cone in shape, painted green, surmounted by a lattice-work supporting the lantern.

Height of light:—10 ft. above the water.

Character of light:—Pintch gas occulting green light; light 4 seconds, eclipse 2 seconds.

Illuminated arc:—The whole horizon.

Distance visible:—2 nautical miles in clear weather.

Depth of water:—About 6 fathoms at L.W.S.T.

Magnetic bearings taken from the buoy:—

- Chimney of the quarantine station at HikoshimaS. 71° 40' W.
- HaneishiN. 49° 10' W.
- The conspicuous pine tree on Hiyori-yama, Shimonoseki.....N. 16° 15' W.
