No. S. 203.—The following Bill was read a first time at a meeting of the Council held on the 25th May, 1933:—

A BILL

INTITULED

An Ordinance to authorize the Appropriation of a Supplementary Sum of Five hundred and seventeen thousand and fifteen Dollars and thirty Cents to defray the Charges of the year 1932.

WHEREAS it has become necessary to make further provision for the public service of the Colony for the year 1932, in addition to the charge upon the revenue of the Colony for the service of the said year already provided for :

BE it enacted by the Governor of Hong Kong, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the (1932 Supplementary) Appropriation Ordinance, 1933.

Appropriation.

2. A sum of Five hundred and seventeen thousand and fifteen Dollars and thirty Cents is hereby charged upon the revenue of the Colony for the service of the year 1932, the said sum so charged being expended as hereinafter specified; that is to say :—
