Until further notice a hydrographic survey will be carried out within the following area :—

Hung Hom Bay north of Cust Rock Beacon.

The survey will be conducted in a series of squares whose sides will run N. and S., E. and W. Sides of squares will be 1,000 feet. Sampans with red flag will be stationed at intervals along two of the sides of the square. Shipping is warned to give sampans a wide berth and is prohibited from passing between the sampans flying a red flag.
