IN THE SUPREME COURT OF HONGKONG IN BANKRUPTCY.

NOTICE.—CHUN-YUN-CHEUN, a native of Sun-On, in the Empire of China, but now of Victoria, in the Colony of Hongkong, Travelling trader, having been adjudged Bankrupt under a Petition for adjudication of Bankruptcy, filed in the Supreme Court of Hongkong in Bankruptcy, on the Thirtieth day of November, 1869, is hereby required to surrender himself to William Hastings Alexander, Esquire, the Registrar of the said Court, at the first Meeting of his Creditors, to be held before the said Registrar on Wednesday, the Fifteenth day of December next, at Eleven o'clock in the forenoon precisely, at the said Court.
