METEOROLOGICAL OBSERVATIONS

TAKEN AT THE GOVERNMENT LOCK HOSPITAL, VICTORIA, HONGKONG, FOR THE MONTH OF DECEMBER, 1877. 137 feet above mean low level of Spring Tides.

Main meteorological data table with columns: DAY OF MONTH, DAY OF WEEK, BAROMETER, SELF REGISTERING IN THE SHADE, MAX. SUN, MIN. DUB, EXPOSED, DIRECTIONAL RANGE, MIN. IN SOIL, DRY BULB IN SHADE, WET BULB IN SHADE, HUMIDITY COMPLETE SATURATION, DEW POINT, WIND, RAIN IN INCHES, CLOUD.

Summary of December, 1877: Mean Shade Temp., Total Rain fall, 3.30 inches. Rain fell on 6 days.
