That the Medical Officer of Health and the Colonial Veterinary Surgeon be appointed a Select Committee under the provisions of Ordinance 11 of 1895 to carry out, on behalf of the Board, the provisions of bye-laws Nos. 6 and 7 of Schedule A of Ordinance 17 of 1887 during the next two calendar months. The Committee shall submit to the Board, every week, a written report showing the steps taken by them on behalf of the Board.

Question—put and agreed to.

It was also agreed that a notification should be posted at the Animal Depôts and served on the persons who are known to import cattle informing them of the steps that will be taken with regard to cattle that are found to be suffering from disease when imported or in which disease develops within three days after importation.
