It is hereby notified that His Majesty the King has not been advised to exercise his power of disallowance with respect to the following Ordinances:—

Ordinance No. 18 of 1901, entitled—An Ordinance to further amend the Jury Consolidation Ordinance, 1887.

Ordinance No. 19 of 1901, entitled—An Ordinance to amend The Probates Ordinance, 1897. (No 3 of 1897).

Ordinance No. 20 of 1901, entitled—An Ordinance to amend the law relating to the manufacture of gunpowder and of fireworks, and to regulate the sale and conveyance of gunpowder.

Ordinance No. 23 of 1901, entitled—An Ordinance to amend the Public Health Ordinance, 1901, (No. 13 of 1901).

Ordinance No. 24 of 1901, entitled—An Ordinance relating to Copyright in Works of the Fine Arts, and for repressing the Commission of Fraud in the Production and Sale of such Works.

Ordinance No. 25 of 1901, entitled—An Ordinance to amend Ordinance 15 of 1887, and to remove any doubts as to the validity of any matters done under it.
