LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS, No. 2.

*Establishment of Light-vessel to mark Staunch Island Rock, West River.*

NOTICE is hereby given that the Rocks (in the West River) near Fist Cliffs known as Staunch Island, (草鞋洲) have been marked by a Light-vessel, which is painted (Red) with the name "Staunch Island" on her sides in white Letters. Her mast, from which a (Red) light (visible in clear weather at a distance of one mile) is exhibited, is surmounted by a black spherical shape. The above Light-vessel, which was established on the 27th instant, is moored immediately below Staunch Island, and its approximate position is:—
