NOTICE TO MARINERS.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Lighted Wreck Buoy, which indicates the position of wrecked third Ikuta-maru, has been moored in the water off Mutsure-jima, Western Entrance to Shimonoseki Strait, as notified with the notification No. 50 on the 5th instant.

The magnetic bearings, taken from the Lighted Wreck Buoy, are as follows:—

Mutsure-jima Lighthouse bears about N. 9° 30' E.

The top of Wakura-jima bears about N. 60° 30' E.

Note:—The Buoy being fixed on the deck of the wreck may sometimes be changed from the present position, when the wreck are shifted about.
