*Buoy temporarily marking lower extremity of Sand bank.*

COMMANDERS and pilots are hereby notified that the N. E. or lower extremity of the Sand bank in the middle of the Anchorage, has been temporarily marked by a Red 6 foot Nun Buoy moored in 9 feet at Low Water springs. This mark may later be moved into 18 feet.

From the Buoy, the Southern Lower limit "L. L." mark bears S. 18° W. 3 cables.
