**No. 703.**—Terms of proposed Lease of Foreshores and Sea Bed, situate at Sha Tau Kok, New Territories.

Notice is hereby given under Section 3 of the Foreshores and Sea Bed Ordinance, 1901, that it is proposed by His Excellency the Governor to grant under the said Ordinance a Lease or Leases of the Foreshores and Sea Bed or land covered by the Sea situate at Sha Tau Kok, in the New Territories, in the Colony of Hongkong, the particulars and areas whereof are specified in the schedule hereto, and the limits and boundaries whereof are shewn on a plan which is deposited and may be seen at the District Land Office, Tai-po, such lease to be granted for the term of 75 years from the 1st day of July, 1898, with the option of renewal by the Lessees for the further term of 24 years less the last 3 days thereof at a re-assessed Crown Rent. The lease to be in the usual form of Lease of Agricultural Lands in the New Territories and to contain a special covenant that the said premises are to be used solely for the purposes of Agriculture.
