WRECK IN NEWCHWANG HARBOUR REMOVED.

REFERRING to Notice to Mariners No. 401, of the 13th September 1904, notice is hereby given that the wreck of the S.S. *Yatsuni Maru*, sunk in Newchwang Harbour off the Custom House in mid-stream, in 5 fathoms of water at low water of spring tides, has been removed and is no longer a danger to navigation.

Vessels are, however, cautioned not to anchor over the wreck, the position of which is shown by range beacons on the south bank of the river.
