Order made by the Officer Administering the Government in Council under sections 3 and 4 of the Importation and Exportation Ordinance, 1915, Ordinance No. 32 of 1915, on the 30th day of January, 1919.

I.—Rule 41, which was published in the *Gazette* of the 18th August, 1916, and which was subsequently amended, and the Schedule thereto, which was published in the *Gazette* of the 18th August, 1916, and which was also subsequently amended, are repealed, and the following Rule and Schedule are substituted therefor:—

Military
Stores.

41. The exportation of the goods mentioned in the Schedule hereto is hereby prohibited as follows:—

- (1) Goods marked (A), to all destinations;
- (2) Goods marked (B), to all destinations other than destinations in the United Kingdom and British Possessions and Protectorates;
- (3) Goods marked (C), to all destinations in European and Asiatic Russia and in other foreign countries in Europe and on the Mediterranean, except France and French Possessions, Italy and Italian Possessions, Portugal, Belgium, Greece, Spain, and Morocco;
- (4) Goods marked (D), to all destinations other than destinations in the United Kingdom, British Possessions and Protectorates, France, and Italy;
- (5) Goods marked (E), to all destinations other than destinations in the United Kingdom.

NOTE (1).—A reference to the restrictions previously in force will be found in the Notes to Notification No. 18 which was published in the *Gazette* of the 10th January, 1919.

NOTE (2).—Rule 38, published in the *Gazette* of the 5th May, 1916, prohibits the exportation of Chinese cash except to China.

NOTE (3).—Rule 49, which was published in the *Gazette* of the 5th October, 1917, prohibits the exportation or importation of any silver subsidiary coins of the Straits Settlements.

NOTE (4).—Application may be made to the Superintendent of Imports and Exports for information as to the conditions on which special licences will be granted for the exportation of prohibited articles.
