No. 78.

Regulations made by the Officer Administering the Government in Council under Section 95 (e) of the Liquors Consolidation Ordinance, 1911, Ordinance No. 9 of 1911, this 20th day of February, 1919.

The regulations made by the Governor in Council under Section 95 (e) of the Liquors Consolidation Ordinance, 1911, under the heading "Distilleries" published on pages 299 to 301 of the Regulations of Hongkong, 1914, are hereby amended by numbering regulation "4" of the said regulations as "4 (1)" and by adding after the regulation 4 (1) the following regulation:—

"4.—(2.) Subject as hereinafter provided such foil and counterfoil duly filled in and signed shall be deemed to be a valid removal permit as required by section 60 of the Ordinance except in the case of liquor removed for export or to a general bonded or licensed warehouse: Provided that the licensee shall pay to the Superintendent at times appointed by him all duties payable in respect of liquor removed under this Regulation.

Provided further that the provisions of this sub-regulation shall not apply to any distillery the licensee of which has been notified to the contrary in writing by the Superintendent."
