No. 140.—It is hereby notified that the following telegram has been received from the Chief Censor in England:—

Commercial telegrams may be exchanged with the inhabitants of German territory on left bank Rhine now in occupation of Allied Forces provided such telegrams relate only to supply of goods to that territory.

Personal telegrams may not be exchanged with inhabitants but are permissible in communication with members of Allied Occupying Forces.

These instructions do not apply to telegrams exchanged with Alsace Lorraine or Luxemburg.

Telegrams to and from Alsace Lorraine are allowed under the same conditions as to and from France.

Telegrams to and from Luxemburg are allowed as to and from neutral countries in Europe.
