

No. 151.—It is hereby notified that the following telegram has been received from the Chief Cable Censor in London :—

Telegrams both personal and commercial now allowed with Esthonia and with Poland from April 1st. Also with Austria from April 2nd but not Hungary. Service uncertain and telegrams liable to delay.

No. 152.—It is hereby notified that information has been received from the Secretary of State for the Colonies to the effect that the Board of Trade has issued a general licence permitting importation into the United Kingdom of the articles on the Prohibited Imports List when they are exported from *and* are produce or manufactures of any part of the Empire. For the present the licence will not apply to

- (a) Gold or articles containing gold except when consigned direct for the Bank of England ;
- (b) Spirits other than Brandy and Rum ;
- (c) Hops.
