BE it enacted by the Governor of Hongkong, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.      1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Military Service Repeal Ordinance, 1919.

Repeal of Ordinances No. 19 of 1917 and No. 9 of 1918.      2. The Military Service Ordinance, 1917, and the General Military Service Ordinance, 1918, are hereby repealed.
