

4. In view of the loss shown in the Valuation there is no profit available for distribution under Article 100 of the Articles of Association of the Company or otherwise.

5. The deficit of \$94,176.15 was covered by a Reserve Fund which amounted to \$400,940.27 as at 20th March, 1939, from which Mr. Sturt has recommended to the Company that a sum to cover the deficit be formally appropriated. Mr. Sturt has also recommended to the Company that no further Bonus be paid on policies maturing after 20th March, 1939.
