The scale of fees charged by the Passport Office is as follows:—

Issue of Passport	\$ 10.00
Issue of Travel Certificates and similar documents, each	4.00
Renewal of Passport, for each year of renewal	2.00
Endorsement of Passport, otherwise than at the time of issue or renewal	4.00
Transit visa, normal fee	1.10
Entry visa, normal fee	11.00

2. In the case of visas granted to nationals of those countries which charge British subjects visa fees in excess of those quoted above, reciprocal charges will be enforced, converted, until further notice, at the following fixed rates of exchange:—

Hong Kong \$0.80 = 1 shilling (sterling)

Hong Kong \$1.50 = 1 shilling (gold)

Hong Kong \$4.40 = U.S. \$1.

Hong Kong \$1.30 = 1 franc (gold)
